

LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT IN HEALTH ACT 2007

The South Cambridgeshire District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2021

Made 1st day of March 2021

Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)

South Cambridgeshire District Council (“the council”), in accordance with section 82 of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 (“the 2007 Act”), has undertaken a community governance review and made recommendations dated November 2020:

The council has decided to give effect to those recommendations and, in accordance with section 93 of the 2007 Act, has consulted with the local government electors and other interested persons and has had regard to the need to secure that community governance reflects the identities and interests of the community and is effective and convenient:

The council, in accordance with section 100 of the 2007 Act, has had regard to guidance issued under that section:

The council makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 86, 98(3), 98(4), 98(6) and 240(10) of the 2007 Act.

Citation and commencement

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the South Cambridgeshire District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2021.

(2) Subject to paragraphs (3) and (4) below this Order comes into force on 1st April 2021.

(3) Article 8 shall come into force on the ordinary day of elections of Councillors in 2021

(4) for the purposes of;

(a) This article;

(b) Article 5; and

(c) Proceedings preliminary or relating to the election of parish councillors for the parish of Northstowe, to be held on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2021

this order shall come into force on the day after that on which it is made.

Interpretation

2. In this Order

“district” means the district of South Cambridgeshire.

“map” means the map marked “South Cambridgeshire District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2021” and deposited in accordance with section 96(4) of the 2007 Act; and any reference to a numbered sheet is a reference to the sheet of the map which bears that number;

“new parish” means the parish constituted by article 4;

“Ordinary day of election of councillors” has the meaning given by section 37 of the Representation of People Act 1983; and

“registration officer” means an officer appointed for the purposes of, and in accordance with, Section 8 of the Representation of the People Act 1983.

Effect of Order

3. This order has effect subject to any agreement under section 99 (agreements about incidental matters) of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 relevant to any provision of this order.

Constitution of a new Parish

4. (1) A new parish, comprising the area outlined with a red line on the map, shall be constituted within the district.

(2) The name of the new parish shall be Northstowe Town Council.

(3) In consequence of paragraph (1) of this article the area of the new parish shall cease to be part of the existing parishes of Longstanton and Oakington & Westwick.

Calculation of budget requirements

5. For the purposes of regulation 3 of the Local Government Finance (New Parishes) (England) Regulations 2008 there is specified in relation to the parish of Northstowe the sum of £66,472.80.

Parish council for the parish of Northstowe

6. (1) There shall be a parish council for the parish of Northstowe.

(2) The name of that council shall be "Northstowe Town Council".

Elections for the Parish of Northstowe

7. (1) The election of all parish councillors for the parish of Northstowe shall be held on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2021.

(2) The term of office of every parish councillor elected on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2021 for the parish of Northstowe shall be one year.

Elections for the Parishes of Longstanton and Willingham

8. (1) The election of all parish councillors for the parishes of Longstanton and Willingham shall be held on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2021.

(2) The term of office of every parish councillor elected on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2021 for the parishes of Northstowe and Willingham shall be five years.

(3) Where any provision of an Order made before the making of this Order requires an election of parish councillors for a parish mentioned in this paragraph to be held on a date other than that for which this paragraph provides, it shall cease to have effect to that extent.

Number of parish councillors for the parish of Northstowe

9. The number of councillors to be elected for the parish of Northstowe shall be 15.

Annual meeting of parish council

10. The annual meeting of the new parish council in 2021 shall be convened by the Chief Executive of the South Cambridgeshire District Council. The meeting shall take place no later than 14 days after the day on which the councillors elected to the new parish council take office.

Alteration of parish areas

11. Each area coloured and designated by a letter on the map and specified in column (1) of Schedule 1 shall cease to be part of the parish specified in relation to that area in columns (2) Schedule 1 and shall become part of the parish specified in relation to that area in columns (3) of Schedule 1.

Electoral register

12. The registration officer for the District shall make such rearrangement of, or adaptation of, the register of local government electors as may be necessary for the purposes of, and in consequence of, this Order.

Transfer of property, rights and liabilities

13. The land, property, rights and liabilities described in Schedule 2 shall transfer from the Longstanton Parish Council to the Northstowe Town Council on the date specified in column (2) of Schedule 2.

Transitional provision

14. Until the councillors elected to the council of the new parish of Northstowe on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2021 come into office, the new parish shall be represented by Councillor Alex Malyon and Councillor Sarah Cheung Johnson, District Councillors for the Parishes of Longstanton and Oakington & Westwick and Councillor Peter Hudson, County Councillor for the Division of Longstanton, Northstowe and Over being those persons who immediately before 1st April 2021 are the elected councillors for these areas.

Order date

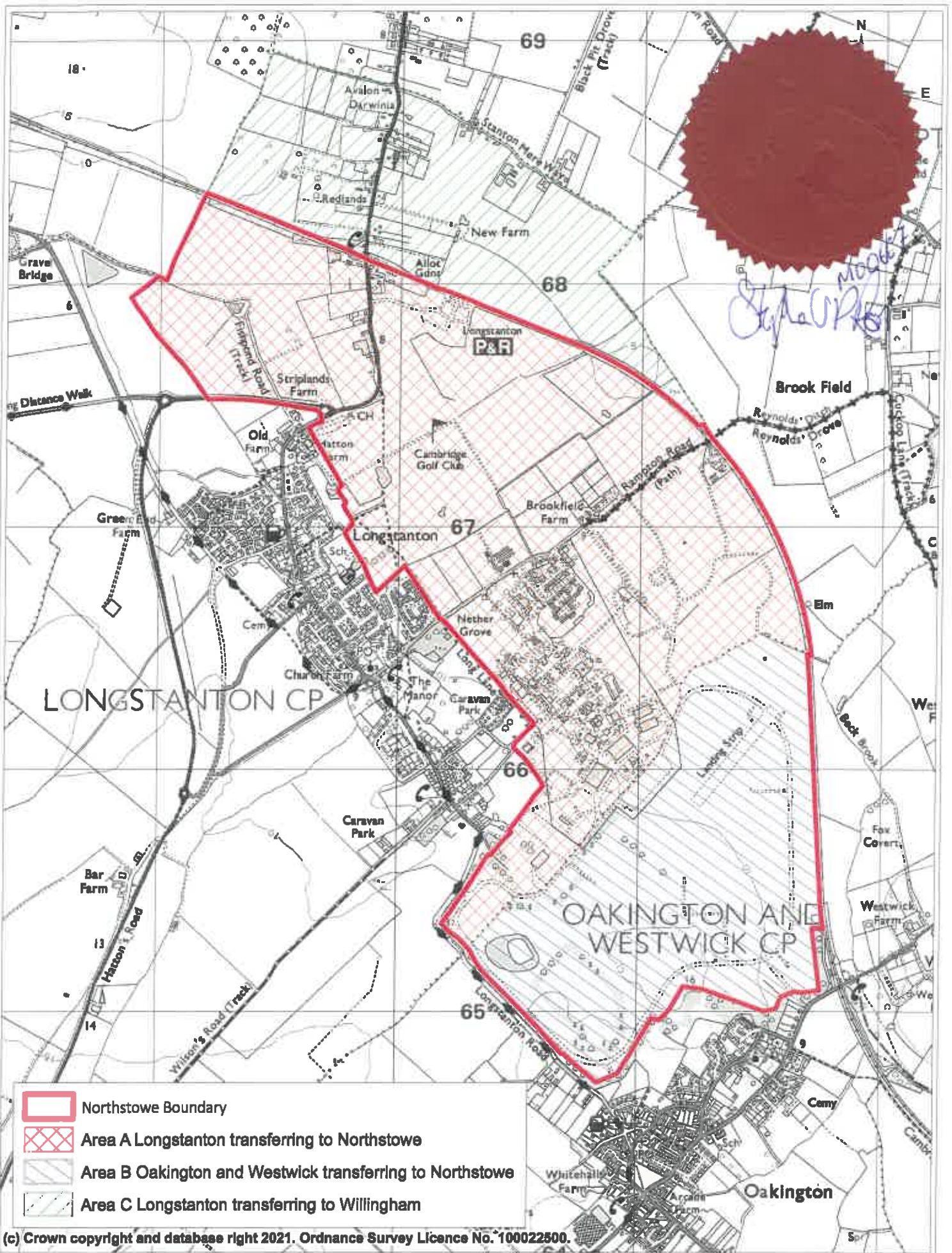
15. 1st April 2021 is the order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) (England) Regulations 2008.
