


# Wimpole Winter Route 5Km

Recommended 1 November to 31 March



## Start/Finish:

- 1 A gentle jog down the main driveway and turn left to the starting point.
- 2 Follow the grass track straight ahead along the avenue of trees, until you see the path on the left, follow this through the gate into the wood. Please make sure to shut the gate as stock may be grazing.
- 3 Continue along the bridleway as it meanders through Cobbs Wood. Named after Geoffrey Cobb, the lord of the manor of Wratsworth; there's now a lost village beneath its canopy.
- 4 Just before you reach the road (A603) take a sharp left onto the path that takes you along the edge of the field until you reach the boundary with Rectory Farm Lane..
- 5 Turn here and retrace your steps back to the wooded area and follow the bridle way back to the finish marker..
- 6 Cool down by returning to the stable block for some well earned refreshment.

## Terrain

Mixed terrain, including kissing gates. Variable path widths, variable surfaces - may be muddy.

Some paths are very narrow, so not suitable for buggies or wheelchair users.

Lots to see, great for beginners.
