Inconsiderate and illegal parking

There is concern about inconsiderate and illegal parking in this area, which can contribute to accidents and injuries. We ask car users to take responsibility for their impact on the local community.

According to the Highway Code, you must not stop or park:

- ✗ Near a school entrance
- ✗ Anywhere you would prevent access for Emergency Services
- ✗ At or near a bus stop or taxi rank
- ✗ On the approach to a level crossing
- ✗ Opposite or within 10 metres of a junction, except in an authorised parking space
- ✗ Near the brow of a hill or hump bridge
- ✗ Opposite a traffic island or (if this would cause an obstruction) another parked vehicle
- ✗ Where the kerb has been lowered to help wheelchair users and powered mobility vehicles
- ✗ In front of an entrance to a property
- ✗ On a bend
- ✗ Where you would obstruct cyclists' use of cycle facilities
